

Statement on Compliance with the Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR)

We hereby confirm that we continuously assess the requirements of the Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR) and implement appropriate measures.

Based on current information, M&C TechGroup Germany GmbH confirms that

- the packaging used is developed and procured in accordance with applicable European and national requirements;
- minimization of packaging materials and packaging waste is taken into account as a guiding principle in packaging design;
- compliance with requirements regarding restrictions on substances in packaging is monitored;
- information on packaging materials and their composition can be provided to the extent required;
- measures to promote reusability, recyclability and the use of recycled materials are continuously assessed and implemented, insofar as this is technically and economically feasible;
- the supply chain is appropriately involved with regard to the data and evidence relevant to the PPWR.

M&C TechGroup Germany GmbH also carries out ongoing monitoring of pending delegated acts, guidelines and technical specifications to ensure the complete and timely implementation of future PPWR requirements. The necessary technical documentation and evidence are maintained and made available in accordance with the statutory requirements.

This statement is based on the current state of legislation and the information presently available to us and is subject to future regulatory changes or new developments within the supply chain.
