

Conflict Minerals Statement

M&C TechGroup Germany GmbH is committed to responsible sourcing and supports international efforts to prevent the use of conflict minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

Conflict minerals (tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold – 3TG) are widely used in industrial applications. We recognize that sourcing these materials from certain regions may be associated with risks such as human rights violations, environmental harm, and the financing of armed conflict.

As part of our corporate responsibility, M&C TechGroup Germany GmbH complies with applicable legal requirements regarding conflict minerals, including Regulation (EU) 2017/821 and, where applicable, Section 1502 of the U.S. Dodd-Frank Act.

Furthermore, we align our approach with the **OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas***, which provides an internationally recognized framework for responsible mineral sourcing.

We require our suppliers to:

- Avoid sourcing raw materials that directly or indirectly contribute to conflict or human rights abuse
- Implement and maintain due diligence processes consistent with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance
- Provide transparency regarding the origin of conflict minerals upon request
- Use recognized reporting tools such as the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT)
- Promote responsible sourcing practices within their own supply chains

M&C TechGroup Germany GmbH does not directly source raw materials and therefore relies on the cooperation and declarations of its suppliers. We actively engage with our supply chain to improve transparency and traceability.

If there are reasonable indications that materials originate from non-compliant sources, M&C TechGroup Germany GmbH reserves the right to request corrective measures and, if necessary, reassess the business relationship.

This statement reflects our commitment to ethical and responsible business conduct and will be reviewed and updated as required.

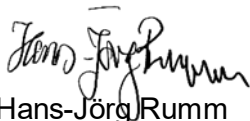
